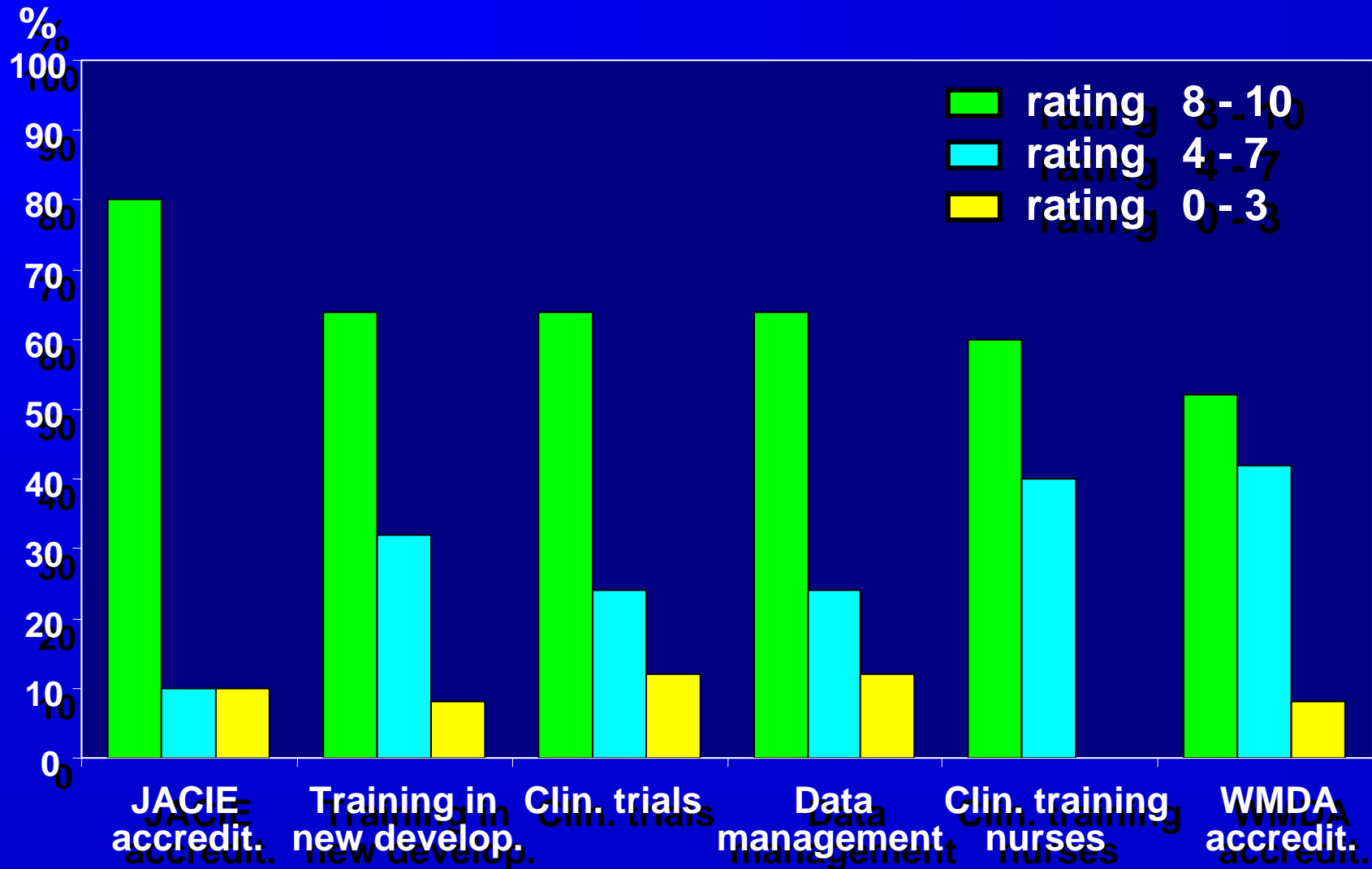

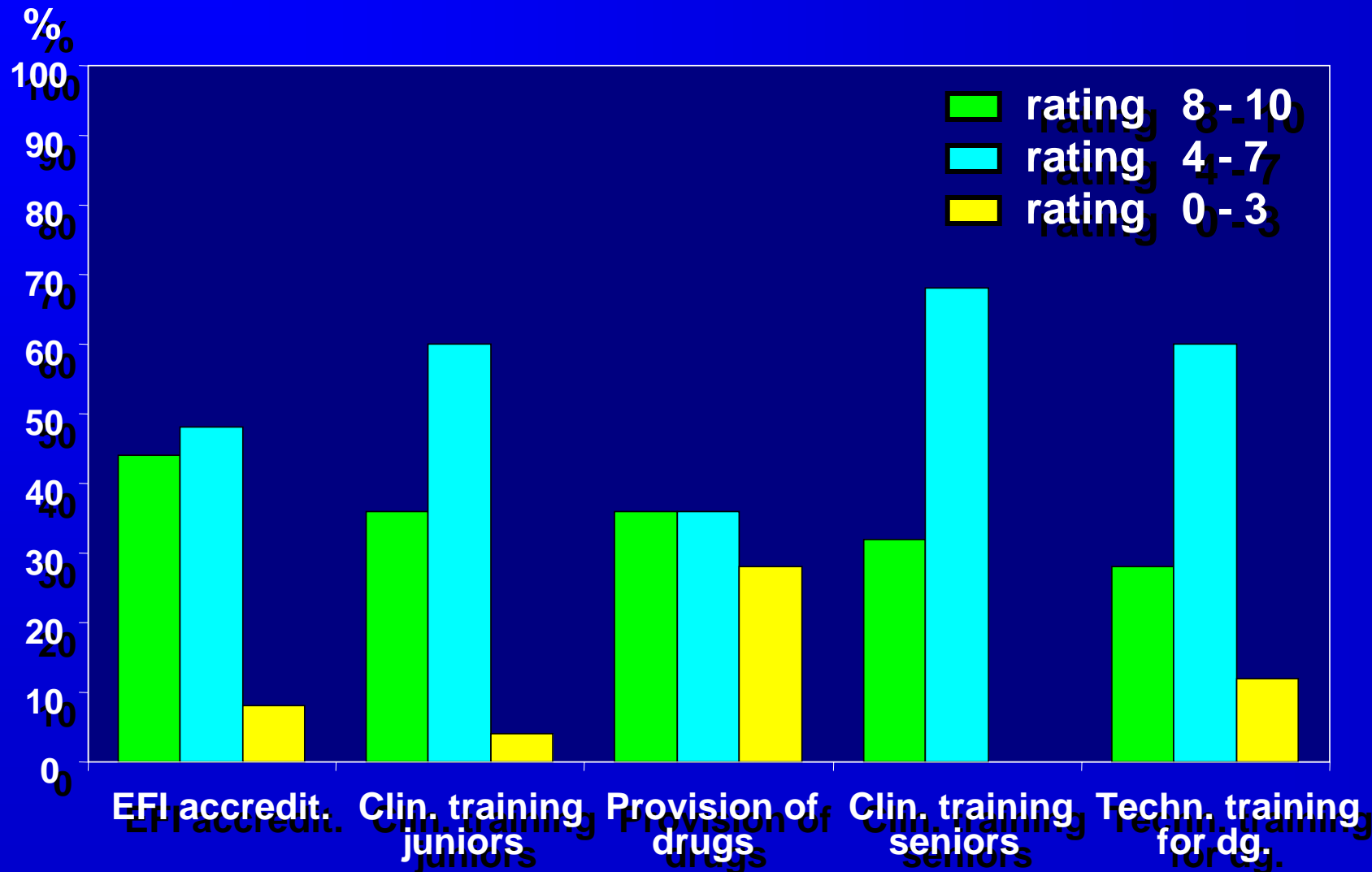

OBJECTIVES REGARDED AS UNREACHABLE WITHOUT OUTREACH BY > 50% OF CENTERS



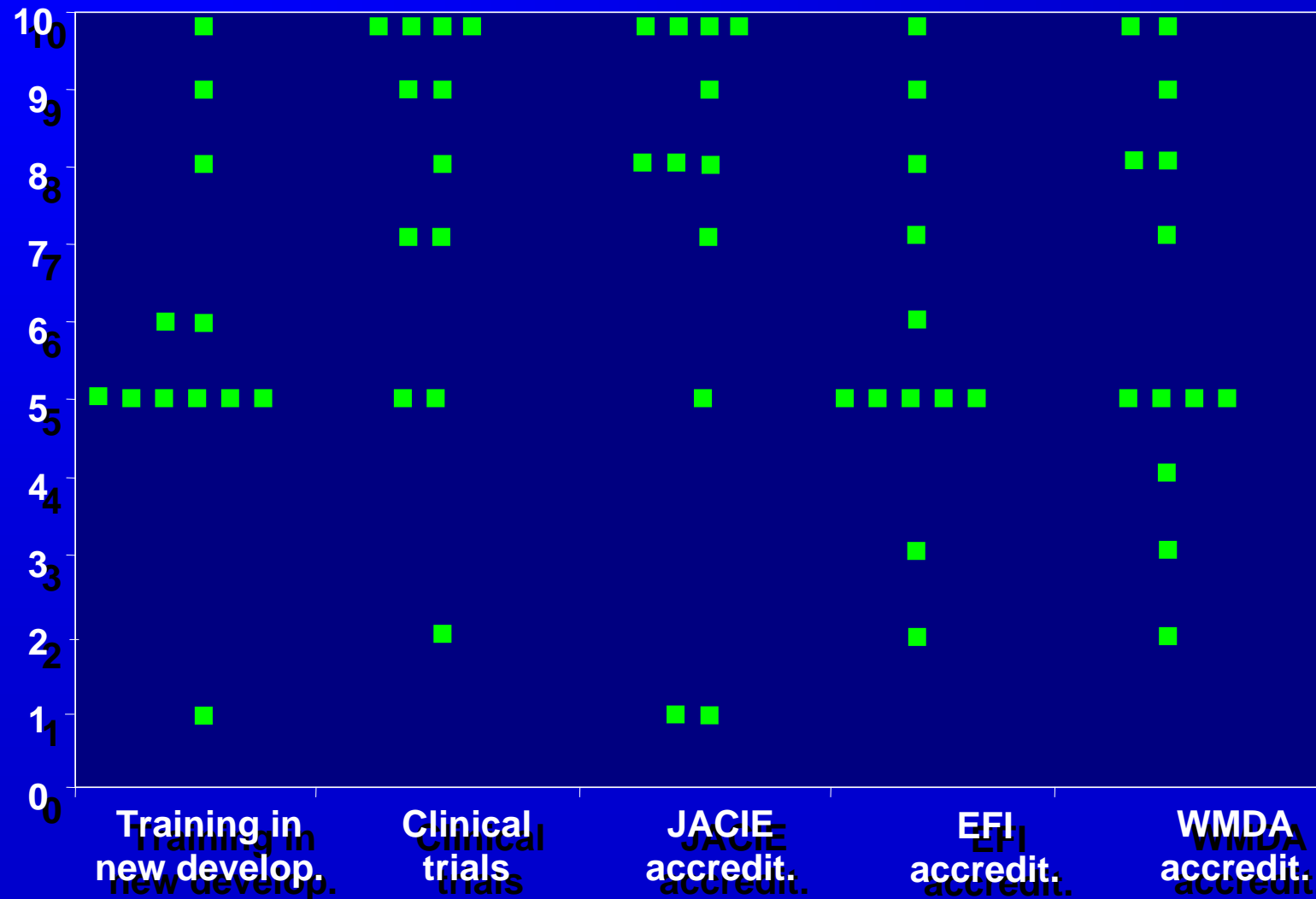
OBJECTIVES REGARDED AS UNREACHABLE WITHOUT OUTREACH BY <50% OF CENTERS




CORRELATIONS

- No difference in rating between countries with different GNP
 - No difference in rating between smaller and larger centers
 - Great difference in rating among centers in one country (with the same health care system, GNP)
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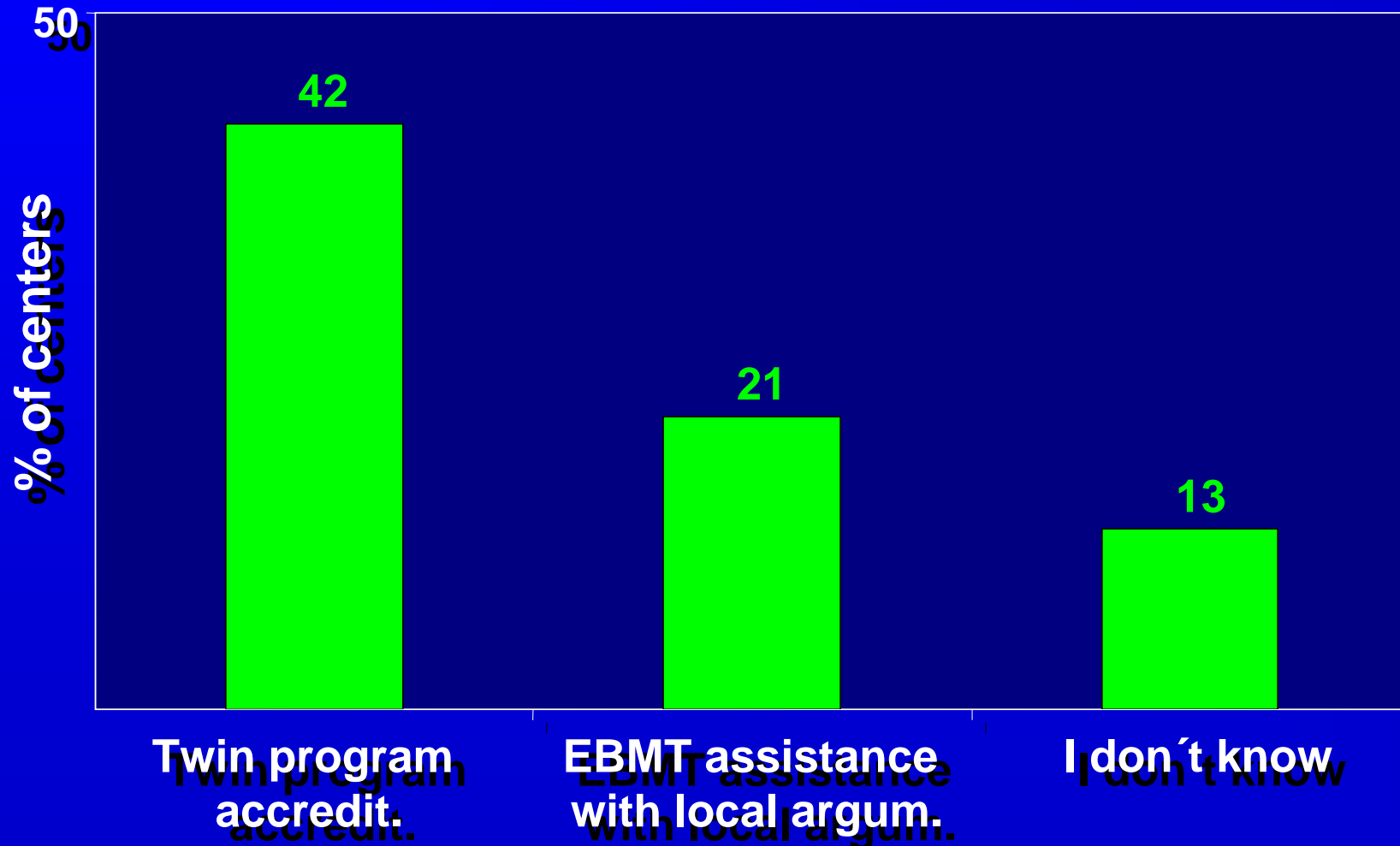
DIFFERENCES IN RATING BY CENTERS IN ONE COUNTRY



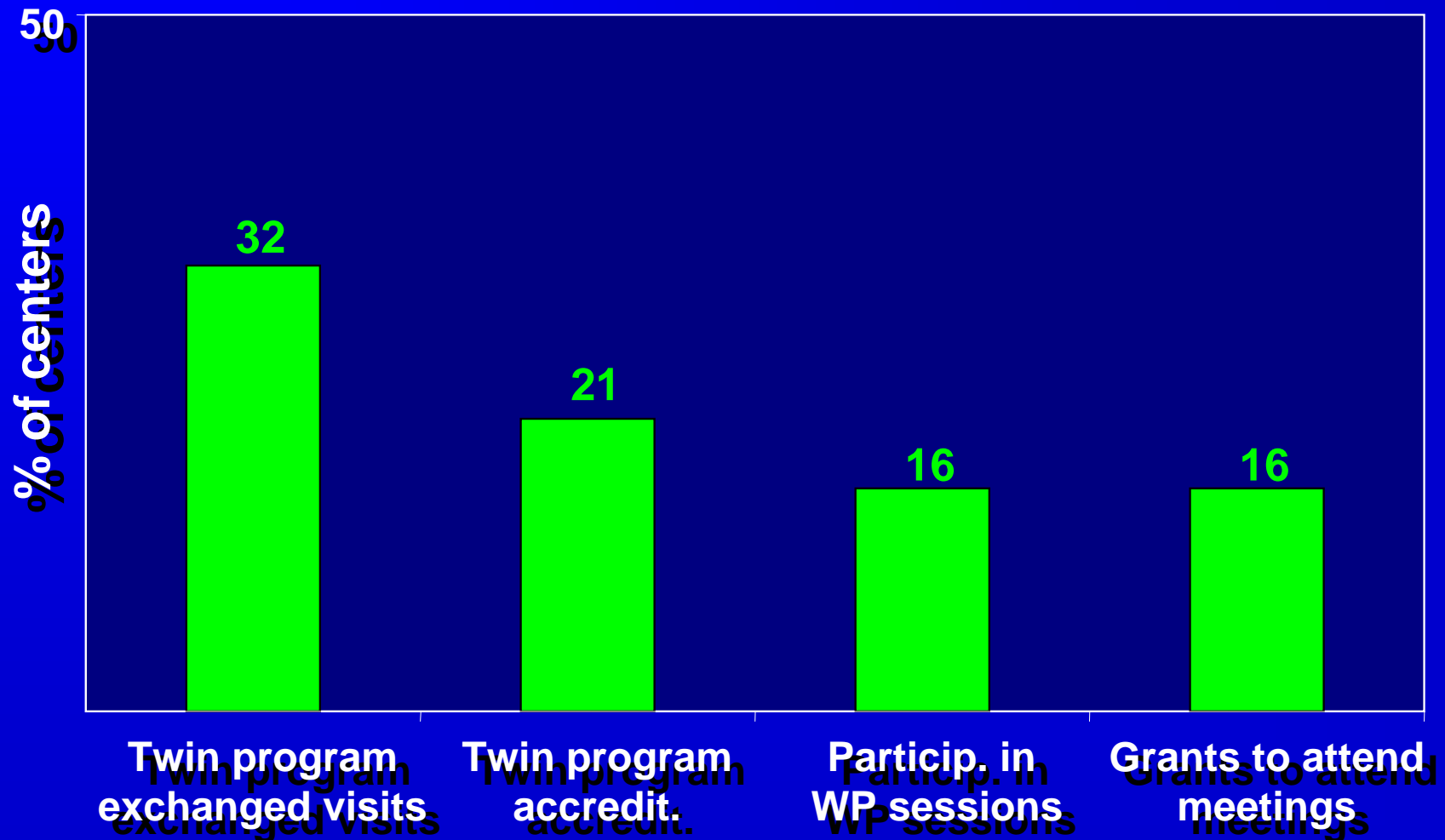
QUESTIONNAIRE II - THE MOST EFFECTIVE STRATEGY

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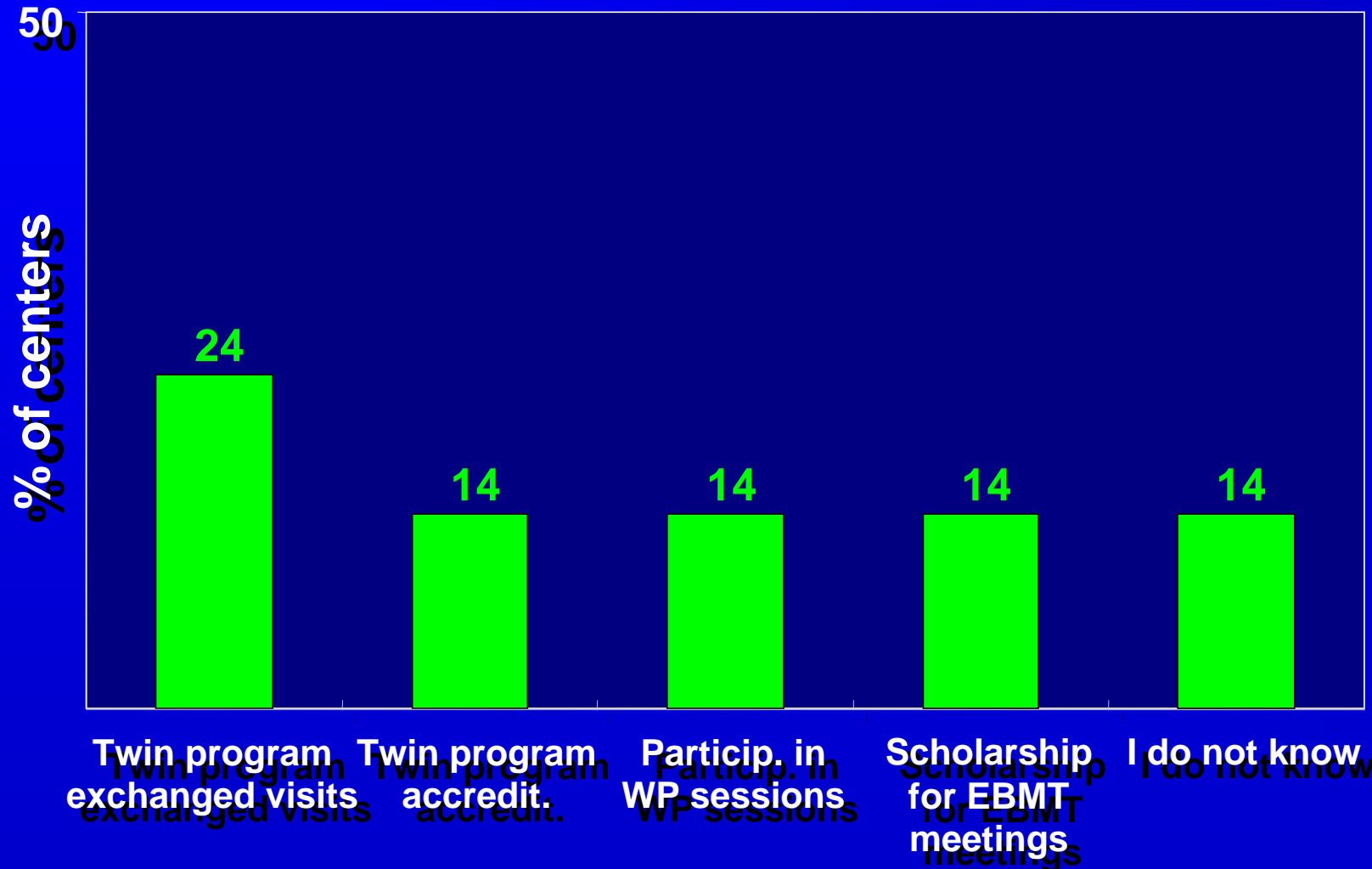
STRATEGIES REGARDED AS THE MOST EFFECTIVE JACIE ACCREDITATION



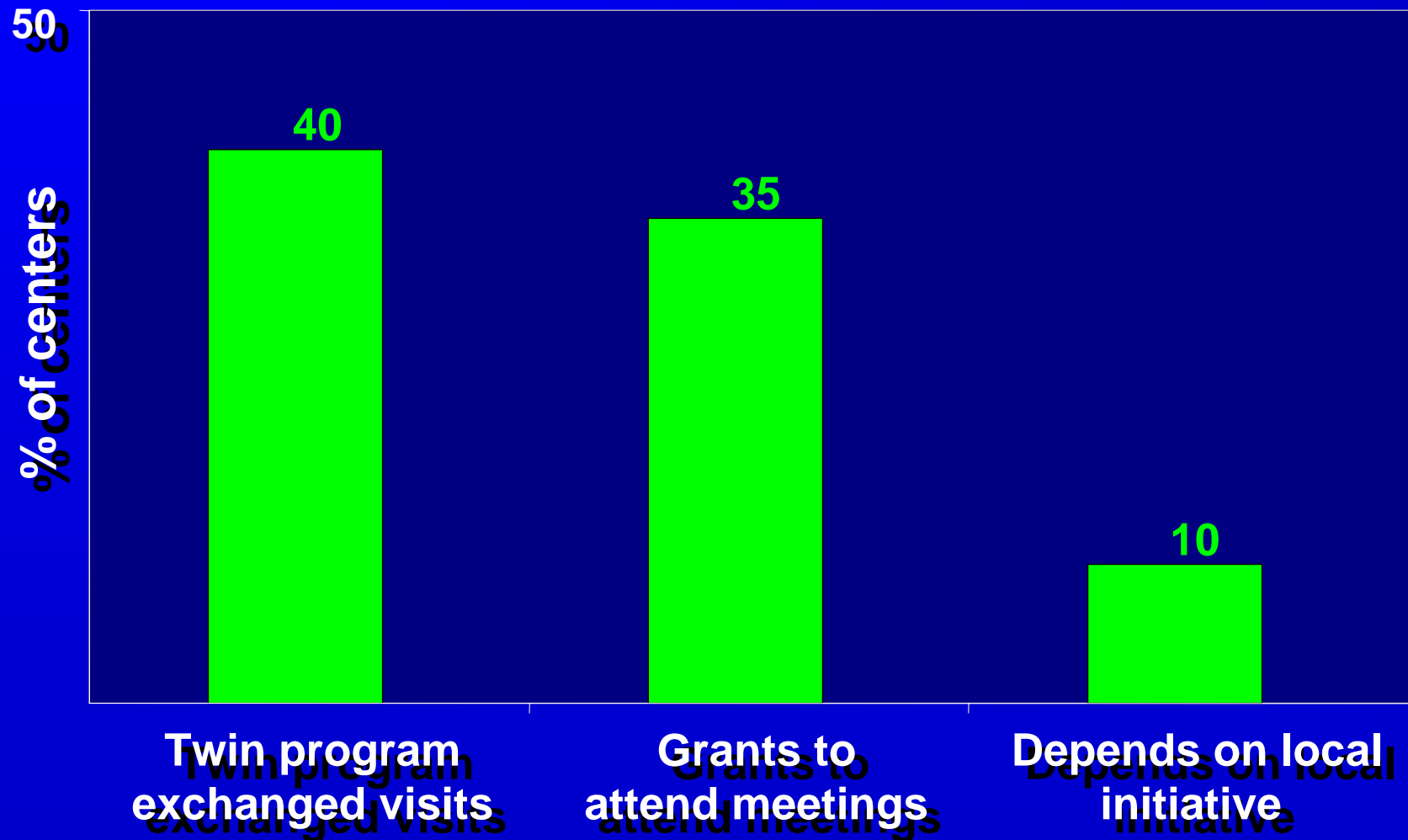
STRATEGIES REGARDED AS THE MOST EFFECTIVE - TECHN. TRAINING IN NEW DEVELOPMENTS



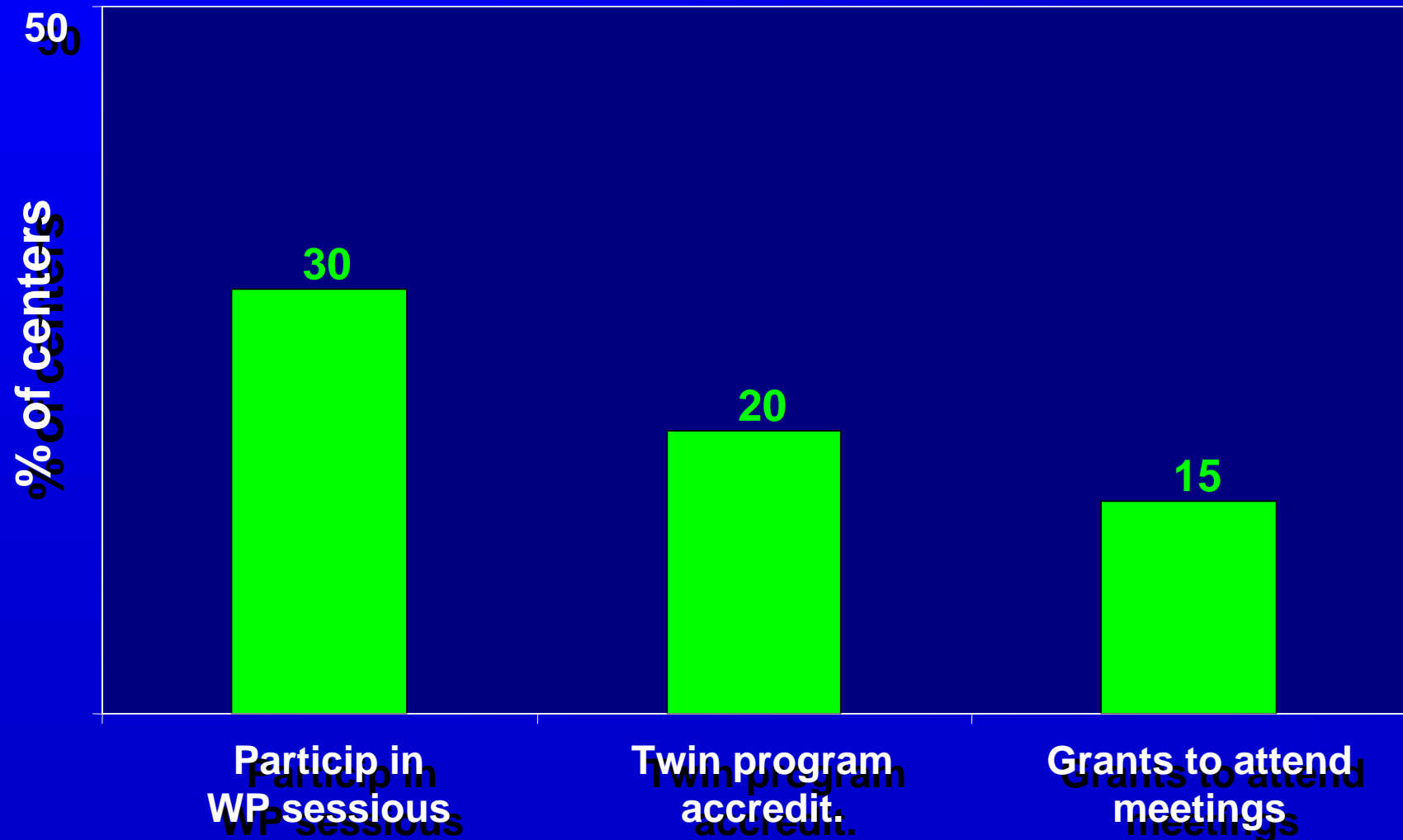
STRATEGIES REGARDED AS THE MOST EFFECTIVE - DATA MANAGEMENT



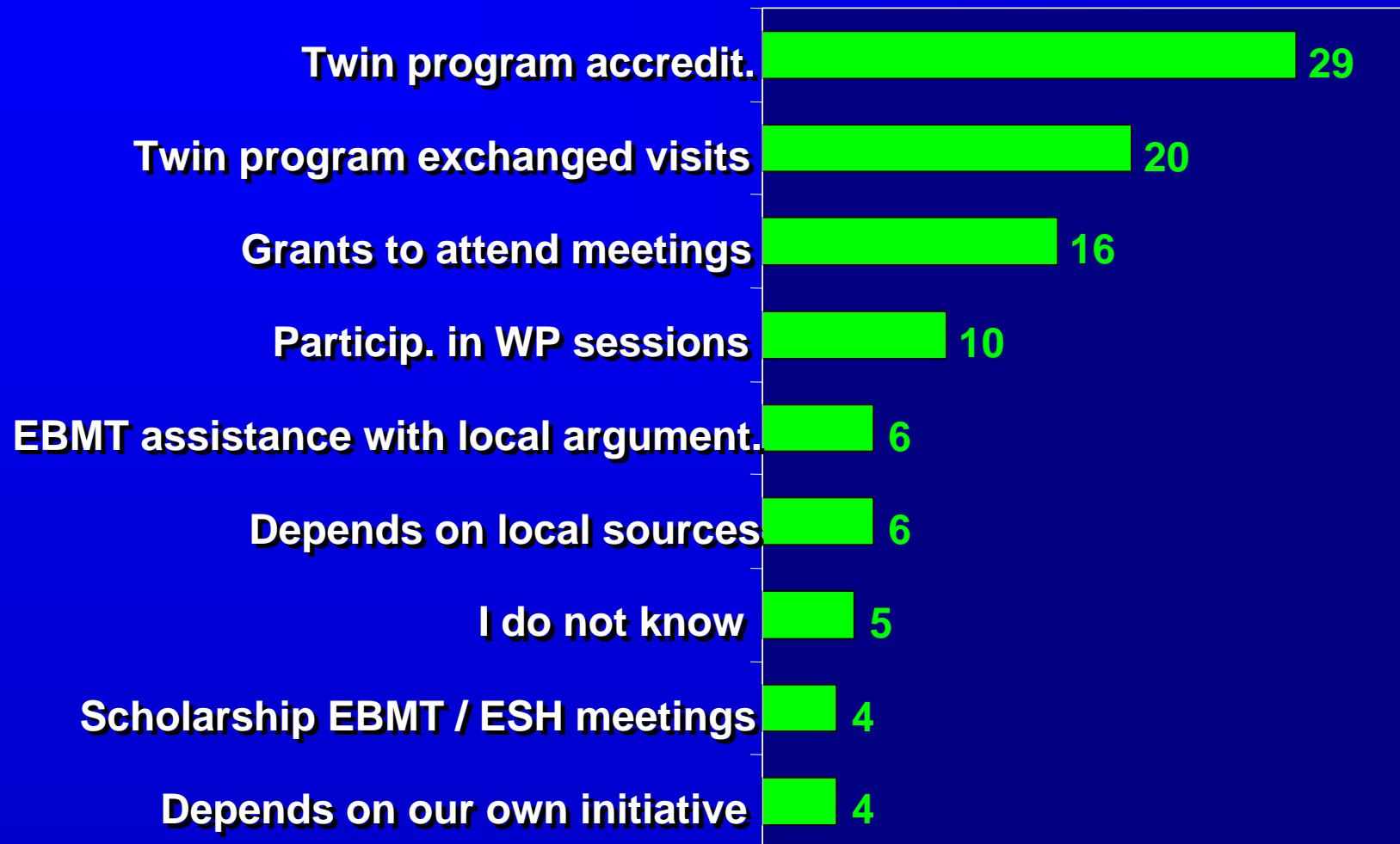
STRATEGIES REGARDED AS THE MOST EFFECTIVE - CLINICAL TRAINING - NURSES

CONCLUSIONS

- View at the most important objectives of the outreach program is not significantly different

- between different countries
- between larger and smaller centers

BUT

- very variable among centers in one country (with the same GNP, health care system)




CONCLUSIONS

- ② As the most important objectives of the outreach program are regarded:

Impossible without outreach

■ JACIE accreditation	80%
■ Training in new developments	64%
■ Participation in clinical trials	64%
■ Data management	64%
■ Clinical training for nurses	60%
■ WMDA accreditation	52%
■ EFI accreditation	44%

 - ④ **As the least effective are regarded:**
 - EBMT assistance by the argumentation with local authorities
 - Scholarship for EBMT / ESH meeting
 - Local sources
 - Own initiative
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
