





Physicians and nurses collaborated in three workshops; the last was in October 2018, in order to create guidance for supportive care in pediatric transplant patients. The final goal is preparation of 2 manuscripts to be published in BMT.

1. Prevention of infection- topics include ward isolation and sterility policy, nutrition, post-discharge policy, vaccinations and Infectious diseases

2. Supportive care beyond infection- topics include ABO incompatibility, Iron overload, VOD, anti-emetic treatment, mucositis management and total parental nutrition vs. tube feeding peri-transplant
