




## **EBMT**

The EBMT is a non-profit medical and scientific organisation established in 1974 dedicated to increasing survival rates and enhancing the quality of life of patients with life-threatening blood cancers and diseases.

EBMT Members – more than 6,000 physicians, nurses, scientists and other healthcare professionals – participate in a unique collaborative network of peers involved in Haematopoietic Stem Cell Transplantation (HSCT) and gene and cellular therapy research. Membership encompasses more than 600 centres from over 70 countries performing or otherwise involved in the field.

The EBMT Registry is the backbone of the EBMT's research and educational activities. The main purpose of the Registry is to provide a pool of data to perform studies and assess new trends in HSCT & gene and cellular therapy. As of 2023, the EBMT Registry has acquired data on over 800,000 HSCT procedures as well as data on over 4,000 patients that received CAR T-cell therapy.

#### Visibility

The EBMT website contains more than 200 pages of content related to HSCT & gene and cellular therapy, studies and the latest news in the field. #### **EBMT Reports on Specific Areas of Interest**

The EBMT Registry is the backbone of EBMT's research and educational activities. As of 2023, the Registry has acquired data on over 800,000 HSCT procedures as well as data on over 4,000 patients that received CAR T-cell therapy. The purpose of the Registry is to provide a pool of data to EBMT members to perform studies, assess epidemiological trends, and ultimately improve patient's lives. EBMT non-commercial Partner of Excellence includes access to a standard data report on a subject within your area of interest. The report will be based on maximum 5 items of your choice and will provide you with an overview of specific information registered in the EBMT Registry once a year.



#### **National Health Authority Requests**

EBMT is interested in supporting the clinical research needs of partners with our extensive data services.

Partners are entitled to request national health authority driven queries.

Based on a specific agreement including a tailor-made budget, partners can use the resources and know-how of the EBMT Study Offices (based in Paris

and Leiden) to obtain reports, anonymous data files or statistical analyses, investigating topics in HSCT & gene and cellular therapy.

Through our experience and collaboration with experts in the field we can advise on the best design for your request.



#### **Collaboration with EBMT Experts**

The EBMT has a network of more than 600 centres from over 70 countries; this allows the EBMT to coordinate studies, educational events and patient care strategies.

Partners will be able to receive scientific input from some of the key opinion leaders in the field such as EBMT Board Members, Working Party Chairs and the EBMT Scientific Committee.



#### **EBMT Stakeholder Meetings**

EBMT is the co-founder of GoCART, a multi-stakeholder coalition of patient representatives, health care professionals, pharmaceutical companies, regulators, Health Technology Assessment (HTA) bodies and reimbursement agencies, and medical organisations, collaborating to maximise the potential of cellular therapies manufactured from cells and tissues of haematopoietic origin. As a Partner of Excellence, you have the opportunity to join the coalition and interact with other companies and EBMT Working Party members, as well as receive scientific input from experts in the field, exchange of information on new developments, open discussions, launch joint initiatives or receive information about potential future collaborations with the EBMT.

Partners of Excellence are invited to meet with EBMT face to face during the EBMT-EHA CAR T-cell Meetings and the Annual Meetings of the EBMT to discuss scientific research options.
