Frequently Asked Questions

How do I register to the virtual meeting?

The registration closed on the 4th of October 2020 at 23:45h. It is not possible to add any new attendees.

What do I need to attend the virtual meeting?

You need to be registered, your device or computer, and a good internet connection. For the best viewing experience, we recommend that you join the conference using a supported internet browser, which includes Google Chrome, Firefox and Safari.

Where can I find my log in and password?

What time zone are the live sessions?

The virtual meeting will be held in Central European Time Zone. Please check your time in this link.

Can I send questions to the speakers during the sessions?

Yes, click the 'Ask a Question' button in the auditorium. The speaker or speakers will answer your question during the Q&A.

Can I download the presentations?

The content is not downloadable, but it will be available on-demand after the live event until the 8th of November 2020.

How can I access the content on-demand?

The content on-demand will be available on the auditoriums after the live event, and until the 8th of November 2020. After that date, most of the content will be available for EBMT Members on the e-Learning platform.

Is there a virtual exhibition?
