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Main activities are:


- Designing the programs for the Nurses' Education/Training Day

PROJECT LATIN AMERICA:

EBMT and LABMT established an agreement to offer collaborative educational activities.

Live webinars for nurses were organized and hosted by experts from both societies.

The objective of these webinars was to obtain the knowledge and skills necessary to guarantee high quality nursing care for patients receiving an hematopoietic stem cell transplant.

All live webinars were hosted in Spanish. The complete course will be available on the EBMT e-learning platform. When all the talks are aired and uploaded, the attendees will have the opportunity to take an exam. The fact of having chosen 10 hours of training is not arbitrary since it is the number of annual training hours recommended in the JACIE standards.

Despite all the difficulties that COVID -19 has faced us ... we have tried to continue working with the same enthusiasm, trying to meet our objectives of collaboration, training and support for nurses caring for patients facing HSCT in developing countries.

In this 2020, EBMT-LABMT collaboration has been a success having:
