The Paediatric Nurses Committee is working on a research project entitled: **Development of expert-based recommendations on prevention and management of conditioning-related skin toxicity in paediatric HSCT patients, a Delphi study.**

Our aim is to start in 2023 with this study in collaboration with our colleague Mihaela Hartmann from Vienna, the EBMT Nurses Research Committee, Paediatric Diseases Working Party and other collaborative partners.


EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES

Paediatric Nurses session during the PWDP 2022 in Regensburg.

The last Paediatric Diseases Working Party Educational Meeting focused on Haemoglobinopathies. The nursing program was divided in 5 sessions:

- 1) Pre transplant care: many topics have been discussed in this session from the supportive care in Thalassemia and Sickle Cell disease to pain management and donor choice.
- 2) Research session: how to write or present a research project and evidence- based nursing have been discussed in this session
- 3) Clinical transplant care: this session was focused on gene therapy and case presentations in Thalassemia including a short video about family perspectives.
- 4) Post transplant care: the nurse's role in late effects and transition to adult care were the main topics. The session ended with a nice and interactive debate on communication challenges in paediatric nursing.
- 5) Nursing challenges: this last session was dedicated at the quality management and differences in nurse's training in Europe and ended up with an interesting round table session on ethical issues.
