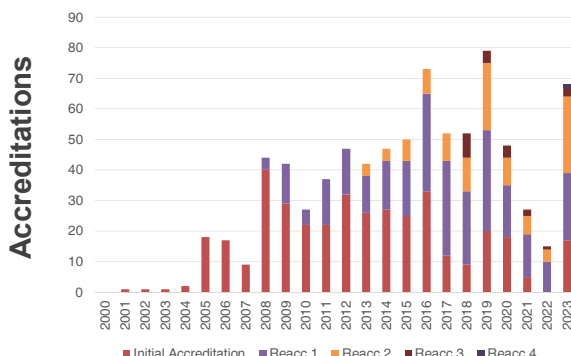
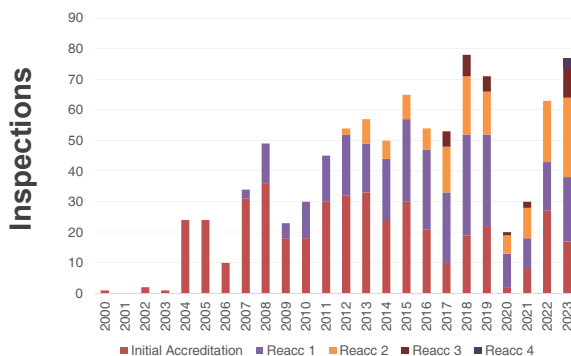
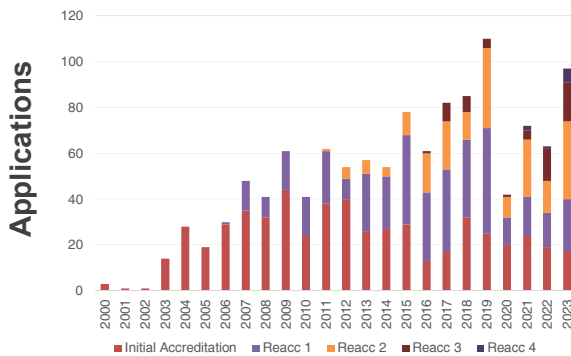


Activity Report 2023
